

Information for Course Selection

You will be requesting your courses for next year at Paly through Infinite Campus.

Please see sheet titled "Palo Alto High School - Requesting Courses through Infinite Campus" for step-by-step instructions.

- 1 All freshmen must enroll in classes for seven periods--including World History, English, Math, Science, and P.E. Jordan, JLS, and Terman staff will recommend appropriate placements for Math. World History is not laned, and students do not select it. It will automatically be added to their list of courses. Students may self-select their World Language and Science courses after reviewing their teacher's recommendation. It is strongly recommended that all students select English 9A.

- 2 Students must be enrolled in and attend a P.E. class in order to receive a grade and credit. P.E. credit is NOT given for participation in sports. Please note that "0" period PE is offered. This class starts at 7:10 am and meets 4 days/week. Students choosing "0" period PE will have a prep during the school day; they may not take 8 classes. Please make sure to select two semesters of PE.

- 3 Athletes: If you plan on participating in a Paly sport, please type "Athletics" in the course search box. Choose the course that corresponds to the sport you anticipate playing at Paly. These are only for Paly sports - not club sport teams. Please see reverse side of this sheet for more information. This does not guarantee that you will make the team you indicate. Do not count these when adding up the number of courses selected.

- 4 If you are genuinely interested in TEAM, choose TEAM as one of your course selections, however, do not count it in the number of courses you have selected, so you should still choose 1 elective.
