Late Registration Fee	\$30 per exam

Special Notes About AP Chinese:

- PALY students enrolled in our AP Chinese class have first priority, followed by Paly students not enrolled in the course by grade level seniority. This will be followed by non-Paly PAUSD high school students. **If you are a Paly student not enrolled in the class, you may get bumped by a Paly-enrolled Chinese student who registers after you.*
- Due to lab size constraints, some students can expect to test on Friday, May 19th. You will be notified of your testing date.
- Please note that due to space constraints, Palo Alto High School will be unable to accommodate non-PAUSD students for AP Chinese.

☞ You cannot take two tests at the same time, and Paly will decide which test you take first. For example, *Computer Science and Spanish Language*. You'll take one of them as a "Late Test." Late Tests will be administered May 17-19. No extra fee is charged for schedule conflicts. Conflicts due to sports, college visits, or vacations must be pre-approved for late testing, and the \$45 late testing exam fee will be applied. See Mrs. Laurence.
